Academic Dean's List Program for the University of North America

The Academic Dean's List is a prestigious recognition program designed to honor the outstanding academic achievements of undergraduate and graduate students at the University of North America. This program aims to acknowledge students who have demonstrated exceptional scholastic performance and sustained excellence in their studies. The following procedures outline the criteria and selection process for the Academic Dean's List program, separately for undergraduate and graduate programs.

I. Undergraduate Academic Dean's List Program

A. Eligibility Criteria:

Students must be enrolled as full-time undergraduate students at the Univers

The Academic Dean's List will be published and recognized by the University of North America in appropriate publications, websites, or other forms of official communication. The Academic Dean's List is typically awarded on a quarterly basis.

The Academic Dean's List program at the University of North America acknowledges the academic excellence of undergraduate and graduate students. By maintaining rigorous eligibility criteria and a transparent selection process, the program ensures that deserving students receive recognition for their exceptional

II. Graduate Degree Awards

A. Master's Degree Eligibility Criteria

Students must be enrolled as full-time master's students at the University of North America. Students must have completed all program requirements and received final approval for their capstone project. Students must have maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.7 or above.

B. Selection Process:

The Office of the CAO/Vice President will identify eligible master's students who meet the above criteria.

The Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, and Cum Laude distinctions will be determined based on the following cumulative GPA ranges:

a. Summa Cum Laude: GPA of 3.9 or above

b. Magna Cum Laude: GPA between 3.7 and 3.89

c. Cum Laude: GPA between 3.5 and 3.69

The distinctions will be awarded to students who achieve the corresponding cumulative GPA within their respective academic programs or colleges. The
